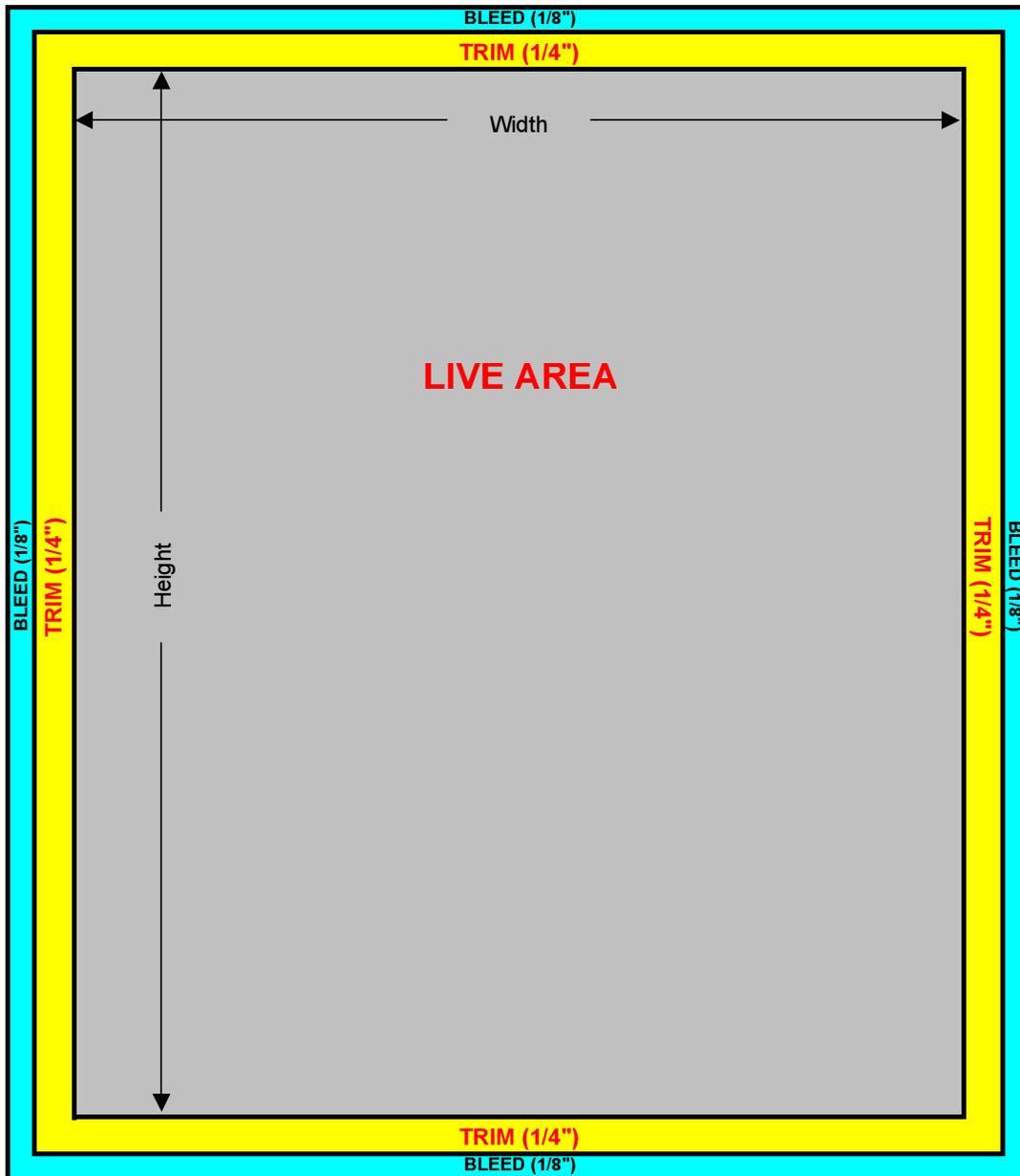


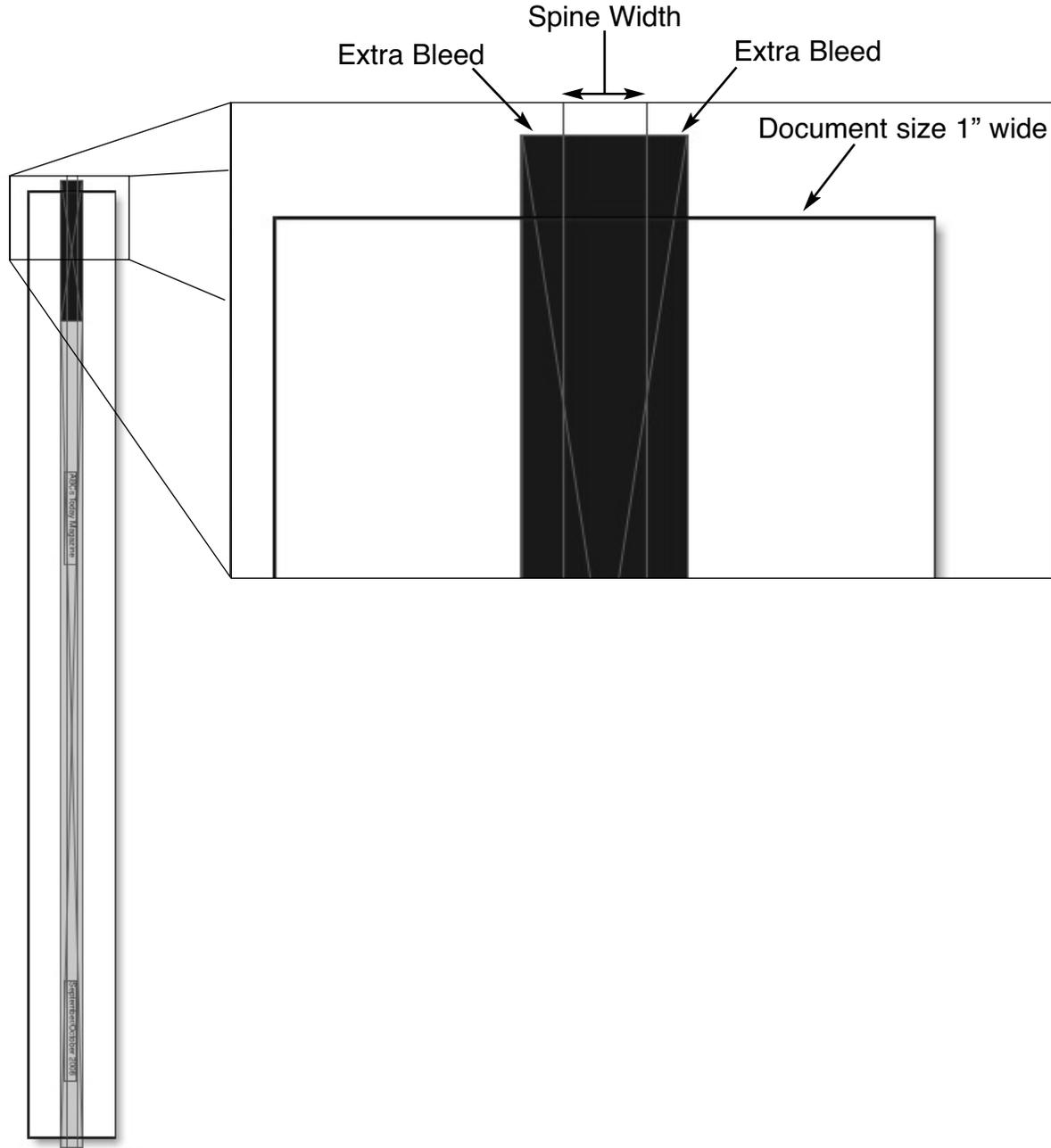
Prepress File Specs for JPA

Attachment A

1. All images that go to trim should bleed/extend .125" past trim.
2. Any type including folio lines should be .25" inside of the trim.



3. When creating a spine file create a new document file and set the trim size to 1" wide by the actual height of the publication. Center the spine copy/image in the document and make sure the image or color on the spine is at least .125" wider than the actual spine width and there is .125" bleed on the top and bottom. If there is an image that wraps across the spine and front cover be sure that it lines up correctly.



4. Images should be CMYK Grayscale or Bitmap (B/W) with a preferred resolution of 350 dpi. Any image with a resolution below 190 dpi will be flagged

5. CMYK images should not have an ink density greater than 290% in the shadow areas
